Booking Terms and Conditions To confirm reservations, Wildly Safari's requires 50% of the total tour amount at the time of booking. Failure to make the required payments will result in automatic reservation cancellation.

The balance of payment is due 8 weeks (60 days) before the itinerary's commencement date. Bookings made within 8 weeks (60 days) of departure require full prepayment at the time of confirmation.

Please note that foreign currency quotations, settled by credit card, will be converted to South African Rand on the transaction day, with any resulting differences or bank charges for the client's account.

Our Standard Cancellation Policy:

Cancellation within 180 days prior to travel: 50% of total tour cost is forfeited.

Cancellation within 60 days prior to travel: 100% of total tour cost is forfeited

Travel Insurance Clients are advised to subscribe to travel insurance covering cancellations or medical emergencies.

Price Increase Quotations and Confirmation Documents by Wildly Safari's are based on external supplier costs. Any applicable cost increases will be the client's responsibility and payable to Wildly Safari's or as instructed.

Passports, Visas, and Children Travelers to Southern Africa must have at least two consecutive blank pages in their passport per country visited. Passports should be valid for at least 6 months after the intended length of stay. It is essential to check visa requirements with relevant

embassies/consulates, and parents traveling with children without the other parent must have a certified letter of consent from the absent parent, verified by the police.
